## **Event Report:**

In the school we organized a few events of the Galilean Nights.

Oct., 12. Alexander Prokofiev ("AstroDnepr" Club of Amateurs of Astronomy, Dnepropetrovsk) carried out 3 lectures for the schoolchildren of the 6-7 forms (approx. 90 children) about Galileo and his contribution to science (http://www.astroclub.kiev.ua/forum/index.php?topic=9933.0 reply 4).

Oct., 16. At the classes "Art culture" approx. 30 schoolchildren from the 5, 6 and 9 forms took part in an art competition "Starry Sky". The rewarding of the competition was carried out on Oct., 22.
