3.In 22-24 octobre 2009, In the Schoole no 14 "Ion Tuculescu", Craiova, Romania, have developed activities to promote astronomy, the International Year of Astronomy and the Galileean Nights among students.

This activity was opened by a short presentation of Galileo, the invention of telescope, materials that can be accessed on site http://www.galileannights.org/index.html

The presentation was attended by 20 pupils each of 5th grade and 8th grade.

"Galileean nights" encourages everybody to go out to the streets and observe the skies. But it was bad weather. I printed the map of the sky and I cast her students. Student Parvu Mihaela could not see any star in the window of her apartment. She was the only student who tried observing the sky later in night. With this opportunity I explained to my students the effect of pollution of public lighting.

Within hours of computer science I have guided students to create short compositions and drawings on this theme. With their drawings I have organized a small exhibition in the school hall.

Firstly, this activity can be regarded as innovative because such activities are not part of the National Curriculum.

Secondary, this activities make students think about the Cosmos.

Thirdly, with this activity they have consolidated their TIC knowledge.

At this activity was participated boys and girls, whatever their astronomical knowledge.

The pupils become ambassadors for the astronomy in their families, in their respective local communities.
