Event Report:

On October 24th, over 125 people met at the Northwest New Mexico Visitor Center in Grants to enjoy the dark night sky of New Mexico and explore the galaxy. Eight telescopes were set up, including the center's 8" Dobsonian and the 12" Dobsonian from the NMSU Grants Campus. Kids attending the event received a ticket for a raffle that featured astronomy prizes like a 60mm telescope, binoculars, astronomy software, and books.
