Event Report:

This event was carried out to observe the Orionids meteor Shower. Unfortunately we didn't have any people to attend the event despite the great amount of advertisement around it. But the three organizers carried out the event as scheduled. We saw 2 meteors in the optics observations and 3 in the radio observations at 126.400 MHz between 23h10 pm and 01h00 am. So we lost the peak of the meteor shower which had hapened two nighths before. But we did a lot more! We observed Jupiter, the Galilean satellites and M31 with our dobsonian telescope and we participated at the Grate World Star Count Program establishing the magnitude of the sky equal to 6. This was the 209th event that took place in Madeira Islands included in the IYA2009.
